



Nickel Metal Hydride Batteries

Nickel Metal Hydride batteries are rechargeable batteries, commonly used for portable power tools, portable appliances, and cameras. Spent or used Nickel Metal Hydride Batteries rated 9-volt and below may be shipped using the following shipping name: Batteries, dry, sealed, n.o.s. (Nickel Metal Hydride Batteries Spent)

Nickel Metal Hydride batteries above 9-volts must be packaged so the terminals cannot contact each other through taping the terminals with non-conductive tape, individual bagging, placing non-conductive caps on the terminals, or packaging the used batteries in the original package. This will help to prevent short circuiting, any evolution of heat, and damage to the terminals.

Spent or used Nickel metal hydride batteries above 9-volts should be shipped in using the following U.S. Department of Transportation shipping description: UN3077, ENVIRONMENTALLY HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE, SOLID, N.O.S. (NICKEL METAL HYDRIDE BATTERIES SPENT) 9, **PGII**
